NEW ZEALAND £42

Cult red blend, highly prized around the world, tastes as good as it looks, does not contain chocolate

SOUTH AFRICA £45

AURELIO SETTIMO LANGHE NEBBIOLO, PIEMONTE

This foody Wine is the more friendly and approachable little brother to the more famous Barolo, made in the same region from the same Nebbiolo grape. This is earthy, complex and interesting and is a great match to truffle or mushroom flavours for which Piedmont regions is rightly also famous.

MOREY ST DENIS BLANC LES CRAIS 2011, CLERGET WHITE BURGUNDY £75

A rare white Morey St Denis with a slightly golden hue having developed wonderfully in bottle. 90% Chardonnay 5% Pinot Meunier and 5% Pinot Blanc make this even more unicornesque - liquid gold

PULIGNY MONTRACHET 2014, BITOUZET-PRIEUR WHITE BURGUNDY £80

From the Les Levrons vineyard, this is top quality white Burgundy with all the elegance and complexity that makes this the most admired white wine region in the world

INGLENOOK CASK CABERNET 2011, NAPA VALLEY CALIFORNIA £85

Made by Philippe Bascaules at the legendary Inglenook estate, Rutherford in the heart of Napa wine country, this has everything you would expect from serious Napa Cabernets made by a leading French winemaker, think Marilyn Monroe crossed with Brigitte Bardot... *Rickie's Favorite!!!*

CHAMBOLLE MUSIGNY LER CRU CHARMES 2001, CLERGET RED BURGUNDY £90

Sensational, mature, complex, as pure an expression of Pinot Noir as you can find

CLOS ST DENIS GRAND CRU 2008, LIGNIER RED BURGUNDY £100

About as much fun as you can have with £100 - a mind blowingly good wine from one of Burgundy's brightest young winemakers, and simply astonishing value for this quality level

CH LEOVILLE POYFERRE 1999 GRAND CRU, ST JULIEN RED BORDEAUX £125

The most famous Chateau owned by the Cuvelier family and one of the so called "super-seconds" producing some of the most drinkable top notch Clarets around, now in its prime

DR THANISCH RIESLING GRABEN SPATLESE, MOSEL GERMANY £50

Such good value that quite frankly you should be showering in the stuff

CH VIOLET, SAUTERNES FRANCEE £60

Brilliant with foie gras or cheese, go on, you know it makes sense

CHURCHILL'S RESERVE PORT (200ML) PORTUGAL £14

Have you forgotten how good decent Port is?

CHURCHILL'S WHITE PORT (200ML) PORTUGAL £16
